Pray when you are worried. Prayer put things in perspective.

Be quiet. Silence draws you closer to hearing God.

Remember to take some time this summer and pray. I challenge you to just be still...and listen.

The Bridges Backpack Program/Hi-Liner Pantry Summer Food Assistance will be offering the Summer Grocery Store again this year. The Summer Grocery Store will be open every Wednesday evening June 4-August 6, 5-7pm at the High School. Enter through VC High School Door #W6 and watch for the OPEN sign by the door.



This is free to everyone to help with the added food need during summer months when children are not in school and school lunch is not available. This grocery store is available for all ages.

The Program does get some food from the Great Plans Food Bank and purchases are made with financial donations and grant funds. Local churches and organizations also donate items. We will have a box at Faith Lutheran for donations that we will bring to the store.




Attention Junior High Youth Group (7th-9th Grade in the fall)!!
