

Installation Day



I would like to invite you to the Installation of your newest pastor, that would be me, on *Sunday May 11th* at 9:30am. It is kind of a big deal both for me and for Faith Lutheran Church.

The Lutheran Church calls this an *Installation* service. An *Installation* is a formal worship service where a pastor, who has been called to serve a particular congregation is officially welcomed and empowered to begin their ministry there. It is a public act of mutual covenant-making (promise) between the pastor and the congregation, signifying their commitment to service God and one another. The *Installation* formally recognizes the pastor's authority to preach, teach, administer the sacraments and lead the congregation in worship, as well as the congregations' agreement to receive and support the pastor in their ministry. Historically when an Interim Pastor serves a congregation it is only for the period of time between when the previous pastor has left, and a new pastor is called. The mission of the Interim Pastor is to aid the congregation in grieving the leaving of te previous pastor and prepare to welcome the new pastor. The Interim pastor is *not* supposed to stay and become the congregation's permanent pastor. Oops! After serving as your Interim Pastor for the last several years it became apparent to me that I felt called to be your pastor. But rules are rules so what can you do? To make a long story short, a lot of prayer, negotiation, bending of rules and flexibility between the Church Council, the Call Committee, the Bishop, Faith and myself to make this possibility of becoming your next pastor a reality. I would like to tank you and all those involved for making this call come to fruition!



Bishop Tessa Moon Leiseth, the bishop of the Eastern North Dakota Synod will be here personally to preach and install me as your pastor. I hope you are as excited as I am for this big day, and I pray that you would join me **Sunday, May 11th** for this special Installation event!

CROP Walk for World Hunger—May 7

The 45th annual Valley City CROP WALK for Hunger is set for Wednesday, May 7 at 7pm on the Jefferson School mile. Walkers may start collecting pledges and making donations now. Pledge forms and donor forms are available at the church.

Seventy-five percent of the money raised goes to fight hunger around the world and the remaining 25 percent remains in the local community in a distribution to the Barnes County Food Pantry, the Hi-Liner Food Pantry at Valley City Public Junior/Senior High, and the Valley City State University Food Pantry. In 2024, more than \$5,244.06 was raised for this hunger relief.



The CROP Walk is a nationwide movement sponsored by Church World Service to raise funds to end hunger and poverty in the Untied States and around the world. Now there are more than 500 communities across the United Sates that participate. Valley City's participation in this event stared in 1981 with the help of the late Rev. Wayne McKirdy (who was a United Methodist pastor), Kay Kringlie, Myrt Pommeroy, and West Retterath (from St. Catherine's Catholic Church).

A new acolyte schedule for the summer will be emailed out soon as well as printed off. Please remember that we would like acolytes throughout the summer for worship services.






Attention Junior High Youth Group!
