There are things that happen to us in life that we have no control over and when our blessings seem to be taken away from us, we can lose heart. We think that today we are *blessed*, but the truth is we are one emergency away from being poor, hungry and grieving. This time of year, it is easy to get caught up in all the activities of life, but Jesus in reminding us that it is from God that all blessing flow.

As you ease into Thanksgiving and begin preparing for Christmas try not to take your blessing for granted. There are those around us who are currently poor, hungry and grieving. Look into the eyes of another and see Jesus staring back to you. For *blessed are you* even though you might not be able to do the things you once did in your youth God is still at work blessing you!

2. No Sunday School on November 30th due to Thanksgiving!






Our Sunday School kids sang a special song for Pastor Jamie on October 12th in honor of Pastor Appreciation and gave him cards they had made for him.


