What language does God speak? The Old Testament was written in Hebrew, the New Testament in Greek and Jesus spoke Aramaic. Some of my evangelical friends speak in *tongues* and tell me that is how God speaks to them. The Gospel of John says, In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1) What language does God speak?

God speaking a particular language may seem like a silly question but how does God speak to us? Does God speak to toads and trees, to flowers and bees? My son Nik often goes without shoes when he is walking in nature because he believes God speaks to him through the vibrations of the earth. Maybe God's language is vibration. That would explain why music has such a powerful effect upon us. How does God speak to us?

Our world seems to have a communication problem. We speak *at* each other and do not listen. We speak as if words cannot hurt others. We divide people into word categories by way of words we have invented. I wonder what God thinks about the words we use. Then there is non-verbal language? As a person who makes a living using words, I find it a little disconcerting that my actions may speak louder than my words. How does God speak to us?

This October I would like you to think about all the different ways God speaks to you and how you may have to intentionally pause and listen to the One who speaks to us in a multitude of ways.

May God's words be a blessing to you this month.



City-County Health District will be administering Influenza high-dose and conventional Flu vaccines as well as COVID-19 vaccinations on Sunday, October 5, at 10:30am in the Fireside Room. The flu vaccinations are available for ages 6 months thru adult. Ask them about RSV and Pneumonia vaccines for adults. You must bring your insurance card—(Medicare Part B (or other Medicare Advantage Plan), Medicaid, Aetna, BCBS, Sanford Health, Preferred One, Medica (not Select Care), Health Partners/Cigna or United Health Care cards

with you and these entities can be billed. CCHD cannot bill any other private health insurer for adults. Those who have other private insurance will need to self pay, and a receipt can be issued upon request for possible reimbursement by your insurer. For any questions, contact CCHD at 701-845-8518.


