Where has the wonder gone

Another Fall has begun. Young people are starting a new school year. The church launches into a new cycle. I think back to when I was a kid, and I remember a sense of wonder. The awe in the colors of a rainbow, the smell of fresh rainfall, the power in a thunderstorm. All these things provided a sense of wonder that I feel we have lost in the super high-tech world we live in today. Where is the wonder? We no longer run our fingers through water, shout at the stars or make faces at the moon. Water is H2O, the stars are classified, and the internet connects us instantly to the world. We have lost our sense of wonder.

Is there anything that can amaze us or that still remains a mystery? We have even put God into a box in our quest for certainty. We have become immune to the wonder of creation. We have become so preoccupied with our own agendas, plans and pet projects that we barely notice a cloud passing over head or dew drops clinging to leaves. We avoid the heat and insulate ourselves from the cold. We are quick to pick up dead branches on the lawn but slow to notice the bird's nest right outside our window. We miss the experience of awe, reverence and wonder of God. Yet there is grace in abundance all around us if we would take the time to wonder. The presence of God is revealed not only in spirit matter - the flight of a hawk, a deer heaping through a field, or just in the wind blowing through our hair. God intended for us to discover his loving presence in the world we inhabit.

How can we regain the wonder we had as children? Maybe it is as simple as *stopping to smell the roses*. For *the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit* opens us to the divine everywhere around us. We all long to experience God in some real and tangible way. But we cannot do that without a good dose of wonder. It is not objective proof of God's existence that we long for but the actual experience of God's presence. What might you do this Fall to open your heart and mind to a sense of wonder to experience the presence of God?

How about this Fall we take pause from the rush of the transition of the season to reactivate our sense of wonder. Here is an ancient prayer that can help get you started; *Dear Lord, grant me the grace of wonder. Surprise me, amaze me, awe me in every crevice of your universe. Delight me in how you play in ten thousand places, each day enrapture me with your marvelous things without number. I will not ask to see the reason for it all; I ask only to share the wonder of it all. Amen.*

Bridges Backpack Summer Grocery Store

With your help, the Summer Grocery Store again served to help lessen the hunger need for community individuals and families. Thank you for the food you contributed throughout the summer that we brought to the store each month. We also brought some of the Celebration Cake Boxes that you helped fill earlier this spring for summer celebrations.

Counting the number of adults and children in the home and weighing the food received is the process through Great Plains Food Bank that we follow.

In the ten weeks the store was open, more than 1,000 family members came and more than 10,000 pounds of food left the store. We have seen an increase each year and it was an increase of about 2,000 pounds of food since last year so it does appear to help with hunger needs in our community.

Bridges Backpack Program will continue throughout the year and bring weekly weekend foods for elementary students' backpacks that we purchase from Great Plains Food Bank. The schools will continue to put those in the students' backpacks at the end of the week in great partnership with this program.

As Scott Johnson, BBP treasurer indicated in church, the expenses for the grocery store also increased this summer but we do have a good balance to begin the school year and we do continue to explore all grant opportunities and appreciate all financial donations. All financial donations can continue to be mailed to Bridges Backpack Program, 674 10th Ave SW, Valley City, ND 58072.



We will also still collect food contributions at the church for the Hi-Liner Pantry. Suggested items for this are individual cups of soup, mac/cheese, or other meals; granola bars, crackers and cheese, chips, jerky, small packages of cookies, nots, trail mix.


Greetings from Faith WELCA,
