The other day, I ran into Dan, an old friend of mine. Dan and I first met fifteen years ago on a mission trip to the Yucatan in Mexico. The trip had an impact on both of us as we experienced extreme poverty. The trip changed the trajectory of our lives in many ways, but most significantly for Dan because he met Danielle, his future wife. Today Dan and Danielle have four children, demanding jobs, a mortgage and super busy lives. Dan and I spent an hour reminiscing about the trips we took together, things we learned and the ways in which God changed our perspective on what it means to follow Jesus.

Dan was raised in a typical Lutheran family in North Dakota, his dad a teacher and coach, his mom a counselor. His parents have worked the same jobs, lived in the same house, had the same friends and been members of the same church for over thirty years.

Dan was raised in what he calls, *behind protective walls secure from the evils of the world without any idea how "the other half" live*. But after spending time working and living alongside some of the most impoverished people in the world, Dan said his life changed not only on how he viewed the world but also what it meant to be a disciple of Jesus.

Dan's career path was to become a teacher and a wrestling coach. But after a few mission trips Dan saw himself in a different light. Dan discovered that he was called by Christ to be the person God created him to be, not the person his parents or the world was convincing him he *should* be.

Ephesians 1:11 *"It is in Christ that we find out who we are and what we are living for."* Today Dan is a husband, a father of four, a worship leader in a Fargo church and he is teaching men how to turn off their screens to be more present with their children.

As I left Dan I thanked him for reminding me of what God had done in our lives and of how God has put us on this earth not to just eat, breathe, and consume but to make a contribution to this world. We are all called to serve others regardless of our jobs or careers and to use our God-given abilities to help others. It is through serving others that we discover the meaning in our lives.

As Thanksgiving approaches, let us thank God for all our blessings and let us be reminded that we *are blessed to be a blessing*. I thank God for blessing me with my friend Dan and for the blessing that comes from serving our Lord Jesus Christ.

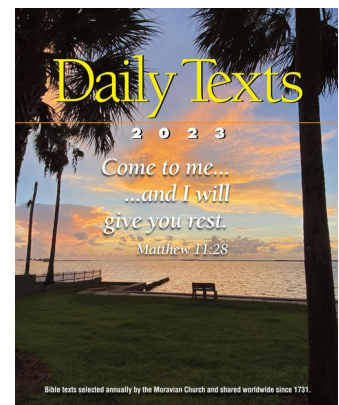
