Is Faith Lutheran a *risk-taking* church? We don't usually think of churches as *risk-taking* organizations. What I mean by *risk-taking* is does our faith push us out of our comfort zones, stretching us beyond our circle of relationships and practices that routinely define our faith commitments. 
