### **Bridges Backpack Program**

There has been a recent change to the Bridges Backpack program, and we want to share that in this newsletter article along with some current statistics of children we are serving with this program.



Our exciting change is that Bridges Backpack Program is now a Charitable non-profit organization 501c3 status and have our own financial account.

As of now, rather than making checks/donations to Faith Lutheran Foundation, all donations can now be made to Bridges Backpack Program. You may still leave your donations in the Faith offering plate or church office and we will get the check/donation to the correct location, or you can also mail your donation to: Bridges Backpack Program, 674 10th Ave SW, Valley City, ND 58072.

We thank you for your past and continued support of this program that benefits the children in our area.

### Bridges Backpack Program Over the Last 10 Years

Childhood hunger impacts our community. Many children in our school district qualify for the federal free and reduced lunch program; however, on weekends many of these children struggle with hunger. Since the fall of 2014, we have purchased and provided over 46,000 meal kits to elementary students. The child-friendly, weekend meal kit includes three meals and snack items. We use the donation funds received to purchase these kits from Great Plains Food Bank. There are no income qualification to participate in our programs. In partnership with the schools, volunteers from churches and community deliver the weekly kits and school teachers or staff discreetly put them into the child's backpack on the last day of school each week. This is how we got the name Bridges Backpack Program! (BBP)

To participate in this program, the child's parent/guardian contacts the child's school to enroll.

In 2017, we decided we wanted to also assist Jr/Sr high age students so the Hi-Liner Pantry was established and provides food and essentials in the pantry at no cost to the students and they may also request a weekend backpack. Inquiries for pantry use are made through the offices, teachers or counselors who coordinate the distributions for about 30 students weekly. There are many heart warming outcomes that have happened since this pantry has been available for student's needs.

In 2022, the BBP started a Summer Pantry program that is open once per week throughout the summer. This program is a grocery store where students and families can come and shop at no cost when school is not in session. This summer we fed an average of 41 children per week and provided over 6.100 lbs. of food to families in our area.

### **Hi-Liner Pantry Items Needed**

Hi-Liner Pantry is again open for the school year. Donations can be brought to Faith, and we will deliver to the High School. Suggested items to donation are: •Cans of soup •Mac and Cheese

- •Individual servings of microwavable meals •Canned spaghetti, ravioli, meats
- Peanut butter, jelly, applesauce, canned fruit, Jello and pudding packets
- •Cereal, crackers, chips, granola bars, fruit bars, cookies and popcorn


### **WELCA News**
