

page Like is or not summer is over, and fall has begun. It is not only a change of season in nature, but also in the church. For many of you, who I will not mention by

name, have been absent during the summer and now its time to come back and join the Faith crowd in church. To ease your transition back I thought I'd give you a few suggestions, instructions that might be helpful.

What to do when someone sits in your pew. We don't like to admit it, but we have our usual spots and when someone is new or has not been in church for a while, they might sit in your spot. If this happens don't panic but try these three easy suggestions;

- 1. Smile and greet the Intruder. Make solid eye contact with the person, shake their hand and if you don't recognize them, offer your name and ask theirs. Try to leave no impression that they've invaded your space.
- 2. *View the 'intrusion' as an opportunity*. Remember you don't 'own' the pew you just borrow it on Sundays. Take the opportunity to get out of your comfort zone and try someplace new. It won't kill you; you may even gain a new perspective.
- 3. *Make an extra effort to welcome the person who displaced you*. Consider inviting them out for brunch or some other act of kindness to eliminate the climate of hierarchy by placing you both on equal footing.

How to use the bulletin.

- 1. *Receive the bulletin from the greeter*. (self-explanatory)
- 2. *Review the bulletin in advance*. Take a few minutes to scan the bulletin to prepare for worship. Check to see if there are other worship resources needed. Often times there are liturgical responses required. A hint is a that your part is usually in bold print. Standing and sitting is also indicated by an *. It is also a good idea to review the announcements.

How to listen to the Sermon. Lutherans believe God's Word comes through the Sacraments and the preaching of Holy Scripture, not to mention getting something out of church.

- 1. Review active listening skills. Even though you don't necessarily get to speak during the sermon, it is a conversation. Make mental notes as you listen. Take mental notes of where and why your emotions react.
- 2. *Take notes.* This will promote active listening and help with reflection later. If the confirmation kids are doing it, you can too!
- 3. Avoid slouching. Sit upright with your feet planted on the ground and your palms on your thighs. Beware of crossing your arms or leaning into your neighbor as these things encourage drowsiness.

Hopefully these suggestions can help ease your anxiety of transitioning back into the habit of worship. Remember worship is not about you but about being in the presence of God. Welcome back and let us celebrate together the beginning of a new season
